Resignation of Licensed Employees

A licensed staff member who wishes to resign from his or her position with the District must give written notice at least 60 days prior to the date he or she wishes to leave District employment. The superintendent is authorized to accept the resignation effective the day it is received and either release the teacher immediately from further teaching or administrative obligations or inform the teacher he or she must continue teaching for part or all of the 60 day period or risk decertification for the remainder of the school year. The Board, at its next meeting, will ratify the action of the superintendent.

In every case where less than 60 days notice is given, the Board may request the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to suspend the teacher's or administrator's license for the remainder of the school year. Exceptions due to emergency or other extenuating circumstances may be considered by the Board.
