# Monthly Project Report

Ms. Kulkarni explained that Dowa and IBI Group are still working on the budget and scope and KPFF Engineering is conducting an analysis on the cut and fill and the lab testing will take four to six weeks to complete. She further explained that the Oregon Department of Education Seismic Grant is offering school districts the option to apply in January 2018 or January 2019. In order to qualify for the grant, the District is required to submit a seismic assessment of the Seaside Heights Elementary School site, which will not be completed in time to apply for the grant in January 2018. In addition, the State Department is offering \$25,000.00 in technical assistance funds to help pay for the analysis which will not be available until January 2018. School districts can apply only once, so the District has decided to wait for the January 2019 submission.

## Financial Report

Business Manager Justine Hill reported that District spending on the Project has been less than anticipated at this point because the project is on hold while the design, budget and scope are being prepared and the contract with Hoffman Construction is being solidified.
