## **Rooter Bus Rules**

A special bus may be provided to transport students to away games. This is a privilege granted to those who do not abuse it. A charge will be collected in advance for tickets to the activity and to cover the cost of transportation. The following regulations must be followed:

- 1. All District bus rules are in effect. Any undesirable behavior will result in loss of privilege to ride and further disciplinary action. (The rules for bus conduct are in the Student Rights and Responsibilities Handbook);
- 2. There must be a chaperone on each bus;
- 3. The bus will depart from school at the time scheduled, it will not wait. On the return trip the bus will wait 15 minutes for tardy riders, during which time the chaperon will make a reasonable effort to locate the missing person(s). After 15 minutes the bus will depart;
- 4. Only 43 Seaside High School students are permitted per 66 passenger school bus (two students to a seat). No other students or nonschool people may be guests;
- 5. Parent permission, in form of a note, must be obtained by the school before boarding the rooter bus;
- 6. All students are required to return to the school on their assigned bus (unless other arrangements have been requested by the student's parents to the school administration);
- 7. Any student who is found to be under the influence of drugs/alcohol while attending a student activity will be reported to his/her parents or guardian and may be turned over to the local law enforcement agency of that community.
